MANCHESTER, N.H.-Members First Credit Union here said it plans to donate to charity any funds it receives in 2018

from reimbursements from NC-UA's Temporary Corporate Credit Union Stabilization Fund.

And it is encouraging other credit unions to do the same.

As CUToday. info has reported, NCUA has said it anticipates

returning between \$600-\$800 billion to credit unions this year after the board voted to merge the TCCUSF into the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund.

The amounts to be returned to individual credit unions have not yet been announced

by the agency.
